

WELCOME

The Ardnamurchan Distillery opened in July 2014, to begin producing what will eventually mature into world-class single malts.

We produce two signature styles of spirit, one peated and one unpeated, which will mature quietly in our warehouse in American and Spanish oak casks until they reach the peak of perfection.

We're delighted to share the secrets of distilling with our visitors and run exclusive, informative and friendly tours year-round, for everyone from whisky newcomers to the seasoned expert.

This is a rare opportunity to see how our exciting distillery blends innovative and traditional techniques to produce the unique and characterful Ardnamurchan spirit.

HISTORY

For the first time in history, whisky is being (legally) produced in Ardnamurchan. The distillery grew out of Adelphi Distillery; a progressive artisan company first established in 1826 and known to whisky enthusiasts and connoisseurs across the world as Scotland's most acclaimed bottler of rare, single casks of malt whisky.

We're very proud that after more than 100 years, we've returned to our distilling roots.

GREEN PRODUCTION

Whisky is a 'natural' product and this is reflected in the way we operate, using green, sustainable processes.

The distillery is powered by local renewables, recycling the by-product of the distilling process as animal feed and fertiliser to be used on the peninsula, reducing our overall environmental footprint.

DANCEY MAN

The 'Dancey Man' is Adelphi's company mascot. He's a mid-19th-century cartoon of Sir William Gladstone, dancing a jig over an ear of barley. This was to celebrate the passing of a new law, which meant that taxes could not only be raised on the amount of whisky left in a cask after maturation, and not on the level that it was originally filled to. This meant longer maturation, lower taxes and better quality whisky - an excellent reason to celebrate.
